## **Welcome!**

## **Cloaks and pegs**

As soon as our building work is complete, your child will have their new peg. Please encourage your child to take off and hang up their coat themselves. Also please ensure that your child's bag of spares and for all eventualities is labelled and on their peg.

## **Outdoor education**

Please ensure your child has clothing for all weathers; a warm, waterproof coat, wellies, hat, scarf and gloves, sun cream and hat, in Nursery at all times as we do go outside every day. This is of particular importance on Fridays as this is our Forest Friday when we stay outside all session.

**Please ensure these are all labelled with your child's name.**

## **Treat Money**

Every week we ask for a voluntary contribution of treat money of £1. This can be paid in the Noddy tin that is left on the nursery top with a list for you to tick. These monies help to fund birthday treats, special snacks etc.

## **Book Club**

We run a voluntary savings club every Tuesday 50p a week. This can help build a pocket of money for your child to spend on a book at our book sales (generally every half term) Please do not send money in any other day as this can become very unworkable.

## Rainbow Day

Every Thursday in Nursery we will be looking at a different colour as a means to learn our colours and to consolidate our understanding. On this day please send your child in wearing an item of clothing in this colour and an object that is this colour. Please do not feel the need to buy anything special, wearing a ribbon, bobble, wristband will suffice if you do not have a t shirt etc.
